We are working feverishly to get ready to welcome students on campus again. We are excited that we are able to do this.

However, due to health concerns of some of our staff, we cannot have everyone on campus for classes five days a week. We are working on a hybrid schedule where high school will be at WVCS on Monday & Wednesday and middle school students will be here on Tuesday & Thursday. On the days that students are not at school, most students will have some Zoom classes and/or will be able to work on assignments.

Fridays will consist of scheduled chapels, tutoring and some math classes. We do not have a schedule complete at this time, but we will let you know as soon as we do.

We will be taking many safety precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

- Students will remain in one cohort, according to their grade level. If a COVID-19 case is diagnosed, that cohort will need to go into quarantine for at least 10 days.
- Students will be checked in and given hand sanitizer before they enter the classroom.
- Oregon Department of Education and the CDC no longer recommends wearing face shields for kindergarten and up, except for medical exceptions, as they do not feel they provide as much protection as cloth face masks. Please be sure your child's mask fits correctly and does not constantly slip down. Also, if their mask is cloth, they need to wear a freshly washed one each day.
- Air purifiers will be in all the classrooms.
- Students will need to maintain 6 ft. of distance, including during lunch, passing time and during classes. Desks in classrooms will be arranged to meet those specifications.
- Desks, chairs, light switches, doorknobs, and any other equipment that has been touched will be disinfected each time a class leaves the room.

We will keep you informed as we move closer to February 1st. Please continue to pray for this process, that we will have a smooth transition and have God's hand in it every step of the way.
