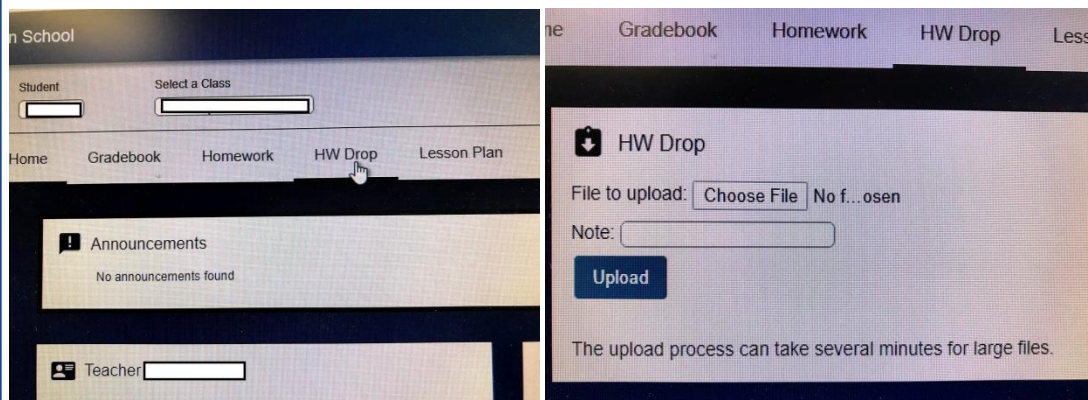


## 2020 Annual Benefit Auction

## 2020 – 2021 Enrollment

Enrollment is now open for next year! Log into the Parent Portal in RenWeb/FACTS and go into "enrollment/re-enrollment" and your student should be there for you to re-enroll. Pre-school, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades are going to fill up quickly, so if you have a student going in any of those grades, you will need to re-enroll quickly. We don't want to be forced to put any current students on a waiting list.
